

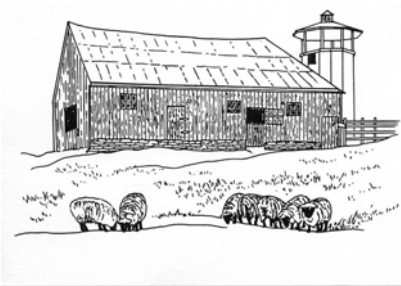

- Correct amount must accompany entry form. Any checks returned for insufficient funds will be considered a void entry. **Any payment received with entries postmarked prior to Sept 15, 2014 will be deposited on Sept 20, 2014.** There is a \$25 service charge for returned checks.
- Entries must be made on official ASCA entry forms, which can be downloaded at www.asca.org/Forms/StockEntry.pdf
- **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED IF POSTMARKED BEFORE August 15, 2014. Pre-entries MUST BE POSTMARKED BY September 15, 2014.**
- Entry fees will not be returned if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire and/or dangerous weather conditions, acts of God, public emergencies, acts of public enemy, strikes or other causes beyond the control of ASCofMA. Entry fees will not be returned in the event that a dog is absent (**see restriction listed below**), disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee.
- Owners of dogs will be responsible for all injuries to livestock. At stock owners option, dog's owner will pay for veterinarian services, or if necessary replacement cost. Replacements costs will be Ducks \$25.00, Sheep, \$100.00, Cattle \$450.00, unless trialers are notified otherwise at trial time.
- This trial will be run under ASCA rules and regulations.
- Owner/handlers are responsible for their dog(s). Dogs must be crated or on lead at all times, except when competing.
- **Please Note:** Entries will be accepted by postmark order.
- Running order will be determined by random drawing six days before the trial. Gate entries will go last.
- Bitches in season will compete in order.
- Any entries received postmarked after Sept 15, 2014 will be placed on the waiting list, in the order of receipt. Additions will be made prior to the start of the trial from the waiting list and are at the discretion of ASCofMA.
- **In the event that any dog is deemed absent prior to Sept 15, 2014, its trial slot(s) will be filled from the waiting list and any entry fee(s) will be returned to the original entrant only, unless the original entrant provides a substitute dog. Substitutions will be allowed with the following restriction: The substitute dog must be owned by the original entrant.**

2014 ASCA Sheep Farm Trial 1

- (1) Take 8 head of stock (3 marked) from pen A to alleyway (gate 2 closed)
- (2) Open gate 2 and put stock into paddock B.
- (3) Handler and dog go to gate 3, then gather stock and put through gate 3 into alleyway C.
- ** (4) Sort 3 unmarked head into aisleway D through gate 4 and shut gate.
- (5) Take 5 head of stock through gate 5 and into pasture E (~3 acre)
 Settle stock on feed, handler and dog proceed to post P. Gather is 200 ft, from feed to P.
 OPEN: Dog stays at P and handler may come 1/2 to stock.
 ADV: Dog and handler stay at P.
- (6) Gather stock, put around P counter clockwise and
 OPEN: Fetch /drive stock to east end of barn. (sp task 1a)
 ADV: Drive stock to east end of barn. Handler may go to corner of fence but no further for all points. (sp task 1a)
- (7) Keep stock in barn (let settle on hay in barn) and handler move back toward gate 5.
 * OPEN: Handler move to west end of barn, about 50 ft from barn, and have dog gather stock from barn (E to W) to handler (sp task 2) and fetch/drive back to gate 5. (sp task 1b)
 * ADV: Handler move to about 1/2 way (end of forest area) to gate 5 and have dog gather stock through barn (E to W) to handler at forest end, and drive back to gate 5. (sp task 1b)
- (8) Put those 5 head into alleyway C. Sort 2 unmarked head from alleyway C into aisleway D.
- (9) Dog and handler go into aisle way D, open chute and put 5 unmarked head into chute.
 OPEN: Leave headgate open and move stock on through into aisle way D
 ADV: Catch 1 head in headgate, "treat for flies, body and head" and release. (sp task2). Put any remaining stock through chute into aisle way D.
- (10) Reunite with 3 stock in alley C through gate 4. Move all 8 stock through gate 3, paddock B, into alleyway through gate 2 and back into pen A

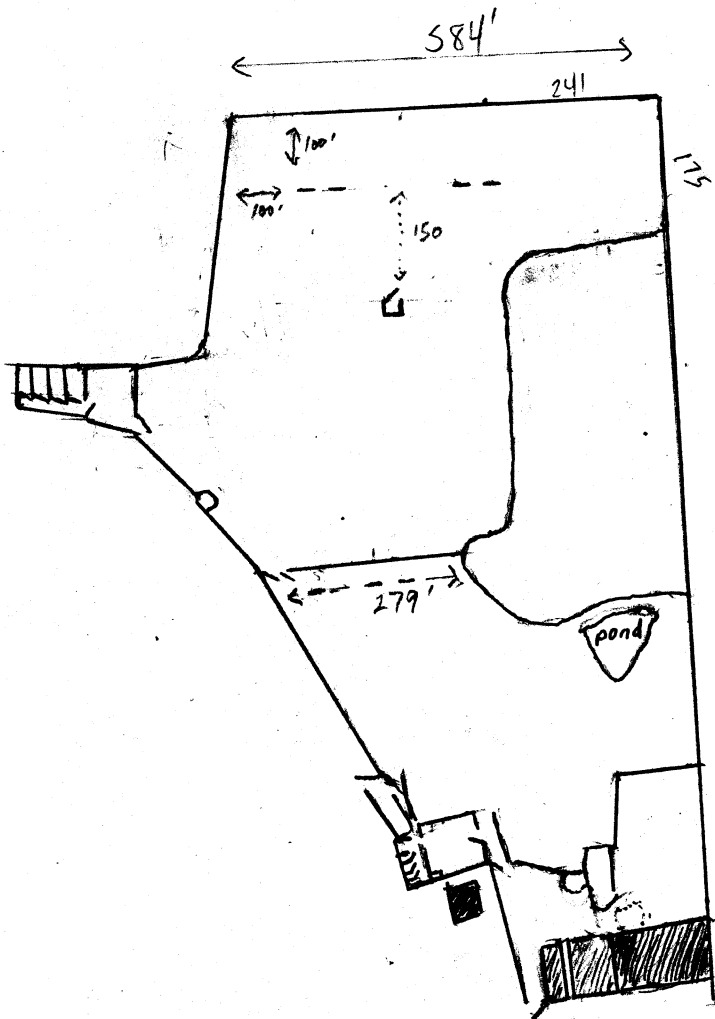
- (1) Take 8 head of stock (3 marked) from pen A to alleyway (gate 2 closed)
- (2) Open gate 2 and put stock into paddock B.
- (3) Handler and dog go to gate 3, then gather stock and put through gate 3 into alleyway C.
- (4) Take all head of stock through gate 5 and into pasture E (~3 acre)
 Settle stock on feed, handler and dog proceed to post P. Gather is 200 ft from feed to P.
 OPEN: Dog stays at P and handler may come ½ to stock.
 ADV: Dog and handler stay at P.
- (5) Gather stock, put around P counter clockwise and
 OPEN: Fetch /drive stock to east end of barn. (sp task 1a)
 ADV: Drive stock to east end of barn. Handler may go to corner of fence but no further for all points. (sp task 1a)
- (6) Keep stock in barn (let settle on hay in barn) and handler move back toward gate 5.
 * OPEN: Handler move to west end of barn, about 50 ft from barn, and have dog gather stock from barn (E to W) (sp task 2) and fetch/drive back to gate 5. (sp task 1b)
 * ADV: Handler move to about ½ way (end of forest area) to gate 5 and have dog gather stock through barn (E to W) to handler at forest end, and drive back to gate 5. (sp task 1b)
- (7) Put those 8 head into alleyway C.
- ** (8) Sort 5 unmarked head into aisleway D through gate 4 and shut gate.
- (9) Dog and handler go into aisle way D, open chute and put 5 unmarked head into chute.
 OPEN: Leave headgate open and move stock on through into aisle way D
 ADV: Catch 1 head in headgate, “treat for flies, body and head” and release. (sp task2). Put any remaining stock through chute into aisle way D.
- (10) Reunite with 3 stock in alley C through gate 4. Move all 8 stock through gate 3, paddock B, into alleyway through gate 2 and back into pen A

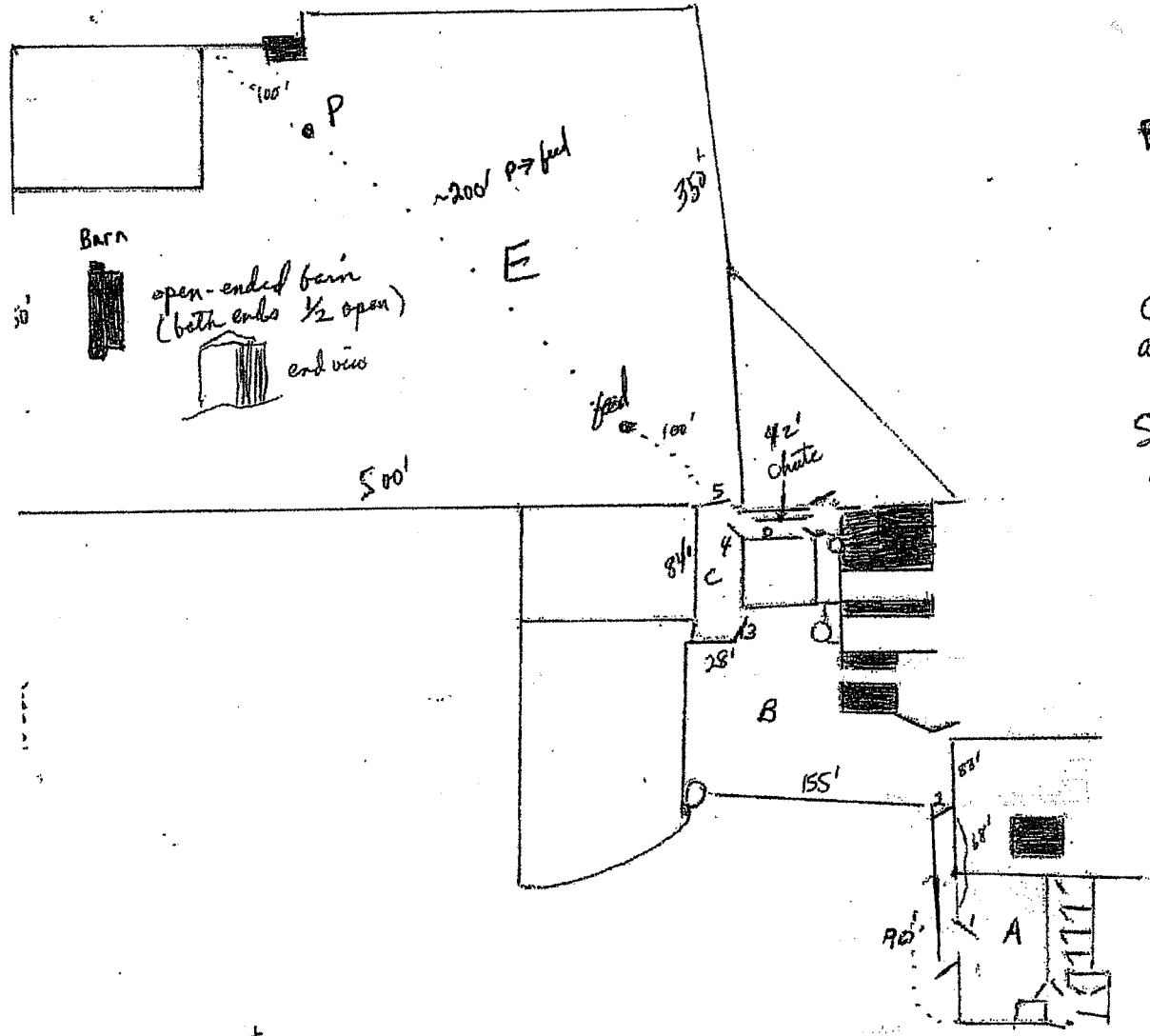

ASCA® Service Membership and Tracking Number Application

In order to have ASCA® qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA® titling certificates, each non-ASCA® registered dog will be required to have an ASCA® Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA® member (minimum membership type of "Service" is required). ASCA® membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA® the show(s) and leg(s) earned when applying for a Tracking Number for those ASCA® qualifying legs earned from 1/1/2003 until submission of application.

➤ FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ◀

Do I have to have a tracking number to compete?

No, you do not need a tracking number in order to compete in Agility or Stock.

You will need a tracking number to enter an Obedience trial or Tracking Test.

Your dog does not have to be a purebred to receive a tracking number from ASCA®.

Why would I need or want a tracking number for my dog?

If you would like to have your dog's points and titles recorded by ASCA®, and if you'd like to receive title certificates in the mail for your accomplishments, you might want to obtain a tracking number.

How much is the total cost for a tracking number?

In order to obtain a tracking number for your dog, you must be at least a "Service" member. The cost for Service Membership is \$10.

- Your membership is good for one year; however, it does not need to be maintained in subsequent years, unless you want to obtain another tracking number for another dog after your membership has expired.

This membership fee is in **addition** to the tracking fee of \$10 per dog. A tracking number is good for the lifetime of the dog. If you only have one dog, the total cost would be \$20. For two dogs, the cost would be \$30, for three, the cost would be \$40, etc.
