- Entry fees will not be returned if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire and/or dangerous weather conditions, acts of God, public emergencies, acts of public enemy, strikes or other causes beyond the control of ASCofMA. Entry fees will not be returned in the event that a dog is absent (see restriction listed below), disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee.
- Owners of dogs will be responsible for all injuries to livestock. At stock owners option, dog's owner will pay for veterinarian services, or if necessary replacement cost. Replacements costs will be Ducks \$25.00, Sheep, \$100.00, Cattle \$450.00, unless trialers are notified otherwise at trial time.
- This trial will be run under ASCA rules and regulations.
- Owner/handlers are responsible for their dog(s). Dogs must be crated or on lead at all times, except when competing.
- Please Note: Entries will be accepted by postmark order.
- Running order will be determined by random drawing six days before the trial. Gate entries will go last.
- Bitches in season will compete in order.
- Any entries received postmarked after Sept 15, 2014 will be placed on the waiting list, in the order of receipt. Additions will be made prior to the start of the trial from the waiting list and are at the discretion of ASCofMA.
- In the event that any dog is deemed absent prior to Sept 15, 2014, its trial slot(s) will be filled from the waiting list and any entry fee(s) will be returned to the original entrant only, unless the original entrant provides a substitute dog. Substitutions will be allowed with the following restriction: The substitute dog must be owned by the original entrant.



## **▶FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**<

# Do I have to have a tracking number to compete?

No, you do not need a tracking number in order to compete in Agility or Stock.

You will need a tracking number to enter an Obedience trial or Tracking Test.

Your dog does not have to be a purebred to receive a tracking number from ASCA®.

Why would I need or want a tracking number for my dog?

If you would like to have your dog's points and titles recorded by ASCA®, and if you'd like to receive title certificates in the mail for your accomplishments, you might want to obtain a tracking number.

# How much is the total cost for a tracking number?

In order to obtain a tracking number for your dog, you must be at least a "Service" member. The cost for Service Membership is \$10.  Your membership is good for one year; however, it does not need to be maintained in subsequent years, unless you want to obtain another tracking number for another dog after your membership has expired.

This membership fee is in addition to the tracking fee of \$10 per dog. A tracking number is good for the lifetime of the dog. If you only have one dog, the total cost would be \$20. For two dogs, the cost would be \$30, for three, the cost would be \$40, etc.
